



Public Announcement: Tuition and Fees Adjustment October 17, 2023

Effective Date: February 1, 2024

Bottega University tuition and fees for degree programs have not been adjusted since before 2018. Due to increases in the cost of providing educational services and support, the per term tuition fee is being increased from \$897 per term (2-4 courses) to \$1297 per term for undergraduate degree programs and \$1750 per term (2-3 courses) for graduate degree programs.

Technology Fees are now inclusive within the price of tuition as distance education may not be delivered without that use of service and support technologies such as the Learning Management System (Canvas), the electronic library (ProQuest), Exam Proctoring and project originality verification technologies. The value of the technology fee is increasing from \$50 per term to \$100 per term and is a non-refundable portion of the per term tuition.

A new fee will be added to the University's fee schedule for extensions with the limits of an active Enrollment Agreement (EA). Effective February 1, 2024, extensions will now incur a \$250 fee after the first 45-day extension for any given course or program. Program extensions may only be offered twice, and only for up to 45 days per request. Program extension may not exceed the Enrollment Agreement expiration date. Should a program extension, or re-enrollment be required, the program re-enrollment fee increases to \$500.

With the tuition and fee changes, Bottega will allow students to pay tuition over four (4) months, instead of three (3) months. This option is available for students who need to keep to a fixed monthly expense for education. However, students will not be allowed to enroll in the next consecutive term until the prior term's tuition is paid. Students may take a month between planned terms and still be considered continuously enrolled.

Bottega will continue its practice to not charge a late registration fee. However, the extension and re-enrollment fees have become necessary to ensure our mission to deliver affordable, high-quality distance education.

The annual total tuition and fees for undergraduate and graduate degree-seeking students remains under the IRS allotted Tuition Reimbursement cap of \$5250 for employer tuition reimbursement plans (Section 127); thus, Bottega's tuition remains affordable and competitive with current industry standards.

Textbooks continue to be the responsibility of the student, unless special program agreements are made. Textbooks average \$50-\$200 for rental or purchase from Bottega's digital textbook provider, VitalSource.
